

# Chalk & Salt Art Jar Project

Fun to work on outside!



*Finished project with added foam stickers.*

Materials required: Color chalk, table salt, other kinds of salt if available, bendable paper plates, jars with lids, tubs or containers for temporary storage of colored salt, and small paper cups or plastic spoons.



**Step  
# 1**

*Sidewalk chalk or  
any colored chalk  
will work.*



**Step  
# 2**

*Pour salt on  
"cheap" paper  
plates that are  
bendable for later  
pouring salt into  
containers. Rub  
chalk on salt on  
paper plate to dye  
the salt colors.*

	<p><b>Step # 3</b></p>	<p><i>Use different kinds of salt, or use whatever is available.</i></p>
	<p><b>Step # 4</b></p>	<p><i>Pour each separate color of salt into plastic bins or available containers.</i></p>
	<p><b>Step # 5</b></p>	<p><i>Work until there is plenty of colored salt. Estimate the amount needed based on the capacity of jars available.</i></p>



**Step  
# 6**

*Using small cups or large spoons, pour layers of different colors of salt into the jars.*



**Step  
# 7**

*Fill jar to very top (almost overflowing) so the salt has no room to mix and therefore blend colors (which will ruin the layers). The lid needs to fit very tightly.*



**Step  
# 8**

*Decorate jar with foam stickers with a theme, or put cloth over the lid and tie with a ribbon.*
